

Sandwatch to restart in Guyana

We, the new Sandwatch Nature Club are currently in the process of revamping Sandwatch here in Guyana. We are setting up a committee with a Secretary, an environmentalist, one teacher a treasurer/accountant and coordinator and about 10 children (12-17 years old) to start. We are taking this plan to UNESCO National Commission for Guyana for endorsement.

The plan is to engage some voluntary recruitment for the resuscitation of Sandwatch in Guyana. We have already involved several experienced people, educators and environmentalists, including Ms. Allande Johnson-Hackette, an Environmental Science teacher who was also with me at the Sandwatch Youth and Climate Change Symposium that was held in Barbados in 2008. We also plan to register the club with UNESCO Clubs so that Guyana can have representation there.
